Choose a career path that genuinely interests you. Passion and enthusiasm will make you more employable and fulfilled in your work.



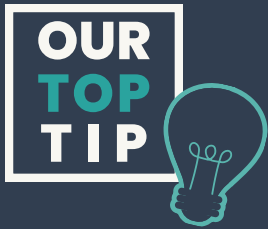
## GAIN RELEVANT CERTIFICATIONS
