Familiarise yourself with the company and role you're applying for. Practice common interview questions and scenarios to feel more confident and prepared.



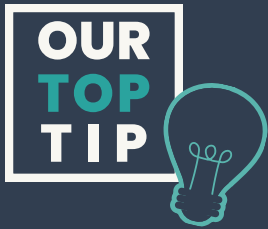
ARRIVE EARLY AND BE POLITE
